
This trail segment will help meet the City's goal to provide alternative transportation routes that connect neighborhoods to community destinations.



Interstate 40 bypassed Historic Route 66 through Winslow in the early 1970s. Following the construction of the bypass, Winslow slowly declined in population. The restoration work through Winslow started in early 2004 and has been phased over the past 10 years. The project preserved the historic character of Route 66 while stimulating the downtown with visitors and cleaning up the old J.C. Penny building site that burned down in the late 1960s. The performance plaza is currently in the final design stages and was funded through Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) beautification, matching funds from the City, and donations from local businesses and the Rotary Club.

Logan Simpson staff members have worked closely with the City of Winslow, FHWA, SHPO, and stakeholders over the past 10 years. We designed the Route 66 streetscape, intersections, paving, irrigation and urban design elements. Preservation of the original Route 66 concrete street was a key feature allowing the installation of an iconic Route 66 thermoplastic logo. The Logan Simpson team is currently coordinating the Performance Plaza, in the last phases of this project.

The project features were designed and phased over several years using a combination of FHWA grant money, Rotary Club donations, and City funding. We carefully phased the final plaza and coordinated infrastructure, trees, irrigation and design elements to fit within the City's budget and phasing schedule.

Logan Simpson is providing design services for recreation and betterment components that encompass five separate recreational trailheads that are programmed to provide gateways to multiuse trails leading to the City's Overbank Wetlands and the Tres Rios Environmental Restoration project. The trailheads are located at 91st Avenue north and south near the City of Phoenix Wastewater Treatment Plant Flow Regulated Wetlands project, and at the south ends of 101st, 107th, and 115th avenues.

Logan Simpson is providing design services for the five trailheads and is coordinating and detailing environmental artwork (betterments) conceptualized by artist Adam Kuby through the City of Phoenix's 1% for the Arts Program. The betterments will be integrated into the trailheads and at various vantage points along the multiuse trails and overbank wetlands. In addition to the trailhead parking lots (porous paving); restrooms; drinking fountains; ramadas; bike racks; picnic tables; landscaping and irrigation; and a future City maintenance building, the project enhancements include seat and artistic site walls, wetland overlooks with canopies, viewing portals, raptor towers and perches, a bat cave, reptile haven, bat garden, relocated butterfly garden, wetland walk, bird blinds, outdoor classroom, kiosks, interpretive signage, and equestrian features, such as parking areas and hitching posts.


