Re: TRANSITION UPDATE: MTS-MSP Multi-Temporary Staffing Services - Managed Service Provider

This message is to inform procurement officers and their agencies' respective hiring managers that we have **confirmed a blackout (hiring freeze) period of Monday, March 10 through Friday, March 28, 2025, as the State transitions from the ACRO contract to the new Knowledge Services contract.** After March 10, all active requisitions with ACRO will be placed on hold until the transition to the new contract on March 29, 2025. During the blackout period, Hiring Managers will no longer have access to the Requisitions module in XRM.

If your agency identifies any urgent needs during this time, there may be opportunities to review *limited exceptions* for emergency situations. Thank you for your attention to this matter. This period will be essential as we ensure a smooth transition to the new MTS-MSP contract.
