SPO Form 109 - Beyond 5 Year Request	 For use when requesting approval of a solicitation or contract that will be over five (5) years in length; and Includes standard work with further instructions.
SPO Form 205A - Annual Forced Labor of Ethnic Uyghurs Ban	 For compliance with the Forced Labor of Ethnic Uyghurs law by agencies with repeated off-contract purchases from the same supplier in the same fiscal year; and Includes standard work with further instructions.
