RED ROCK ELEMENTARY

RED ROCK, AZ

The Red Rock Elementary School campus designed for 1,050 K-8 students consists of four buildings, allowing the district to construct the site in sequence to match student population growth. Included are spacious classrooms with two windows per room and classroom connecting doors, teacher work rooms, ¼ size 'pull out' classrooms, special education spaces, specialized classrooms for 7th and 8th grades and a computer lab, gymnasium with stage, cafeteria and kitchen.

Separating the cafeteria and gym was a priority for Red Rock Elementary School to allow for a wood-floor basketball court. To accommodate this request within budget, we maximized floor space with simple, efficient layouts and focused on materials longevity rather than costly superficial design elements. Once we had accomplished all functional goals, we designed a multi-color paint scheme that resulted in an aesthetically-pleasing façade despite the lack of ornamentation.

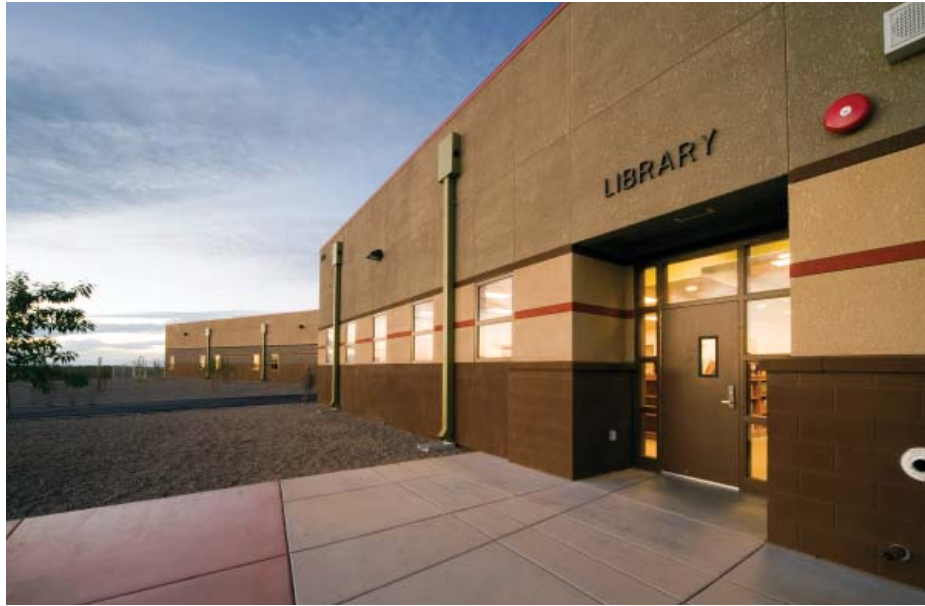

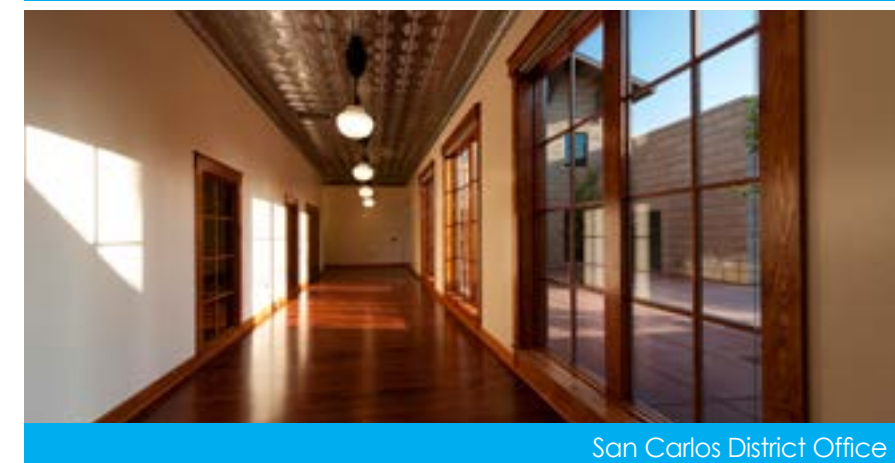
