Re: Agency and Cooperative Member Interest in Vehicle and Aerial Mounted Optical Surveillance Systems

The intent of this SPO Alert is to inquire if State agencies and cooperative members have a need or are interested in acquiring Vehicle and Aerial Mounted Optical Surveillance Systems. Optical surveillance systems allow for situational awareness and deterrence through appropriate technologies and response. Initial research of optical surveillance systems indicates they characteristically are gyro stabilized (for gimbal stability) and turret-mounted to encase multiple imaging payload variations (i.e., laser range finders, thermal, infrared and GPS sensors) as needed for RSTA (Reconnaissance, Surveillance, and Target Acquisition) operations.
