Re: Notice of Final Rulemaking

On Monday, January 7, 2013, several changes to rules within the Arizona Procurement Code are effective. The State Procurement Office has posted the newly combined Code and Rules on the website;
http://spo.az.gov/Admin_Policy/SPM/Regulation/default.asp.

All procurement activities (solicitations, emergency purchases, sole source requests, etc.) initiated and in progress (on the street, in evaluation, etc.) shall continue under the previous procurement code regulations and practices.

All procurement activities currently being developed but not released shall be conducted under the newly revised procurement code.

Both versions of the procurement code will remain on the SPO website for your use.

The parties affected by this rulemaking include: state government officials and managers, state government procurement employees, suppliers including small businesses, minority and women-owned business, non-profit organizations that provide services to state government, associations that represent various business groups, attorneys, and local government units.
