Correction and Addition in Yellow - TIMELINE for both IT and Non-IT Transition

The following is the latest Timeline for Transitioning IT and Non-IT Temporary Resources and Projects.

| Category | Effective Date | Action | Contract # for Purchase Order |

| IT – Incumbents* | Monday, October 2, 2017 | 5% decrease in pay - remain on current IT Professional Services MSP Contract no longer than 12/30/2017. Exceptions: ADOT/MVM and ADEQ/MyADEQ = no longer than 3/31/2017 | ADSP012-031581 |
| IT - New Referrals | Monday, October 2, 2017 | New MTS-MSP Contract with new Bill Rate structure | ADSP017-174599 |
| Non-IT Incumbents | Monday, October 30, 2017 | Remain on current Temporary Staffing Contract until 10/29/2017 under current Bill Rates | Respective Current Temporary Staffing Services Contract |
| Non-IT New Referrals | Monday, October 2, 2017 | New MTS-MSP Contract with new Bill Rate structure | ADSP017-174599 |

***NOTE:** if any IT incumbent resource works on Sunday, October 1st, that time would see the decrease in bill rate and potentially new contract alignment as well.

Knowledge Services will be aligning current administrative/general labor resources to the not-to-exceed rate card under the MTS-MSP contract and sending out finalized spreadsheets to each agency no later than Friday, October 13th to confirm resources' bill rates effective Monday, October 30th. Your bill rates will not increase, but they could potentially decrease depending on the adjustment necessary to align the resources to the rate card
