The State Procurement Office Technology Team conducted a complete RFP and after a detailed evaluation of the 2 bidders selected Metro Institute for the award of the Department of Agriculture contract for Computer-based Testing for Pest Control Licensing. In this process, citizens go to the Department of Agriculture to start the licensing process and then will utilize Metro Institute Testing Centers to take their tests. Citizens pay Metro directly. Metro reports the results back to the Department of Agriculture to complete the licensing process.
