On April 28, 2011 Governor Brewer signed into law Senate Bill 1373 that requires the Department of Administration to report on Veteran-Owned Businesses and state contracts. A new business indicator classification has been established in ProcureAZ to allow vendors to register as a Veteran-Owned Business. If your business is a Veteran-Owned Business and complies with all of the following requirements and definition of a Veteran-Owned Business, please update your vendor profile in ProcureAZ.

The definition and requirements for a Veteran-Owned Business are:

- 1. The business is an individual proprietorship, limited liability company, partnership, corporation or joint venture that is at least fifty-one percent owned by one or more veterans or, in the case of any business who's stock is publicly held, where at least fifty-one percent of the stock is owned by one or more veterans.
- 2. The management and daily operations of the business are controlled by one or more veterans who own the businesses.
- 3. The home office of the business is located in Arizona and is not a branch or subsidiary of a foreign corporation.
